POLICE FORCE

Hopewell Township has a fully staffed Police Department with 16 full-time and 2 part-time police officers that are available 24 hours a day. The Township has an extremely low crime rate. Our police force brought DARE and Officer Phil programs to the school district to enhance student drug awareness and safety issues. There is an annual police golf outing that raises funds for local sports teams sponsorships, players uniforms, and T-shirts. The golf outing proceeds were also used to provide Thanksgiving meals and Secret Santa gifts to local families in need.



ENGINEERING & ZONING

The township has a full time in-house engineer and Zoning Officer that will be able to assist with any questions or concerns regarding development. Our engineer can give advice regarding available utilities, environmental constraints, land use designations, density requirements, dimensional requirements, etc. The Planning & Zoning office is responsible for coordinating the planning, development, permitting and building activities within the community. It is a goal of the Planning & Zoning office to assist residents, property owners, business owners, builders and developers in understanding and complying with the regulations, procedures and ordinances on these matters as established by the Township.

PARKS & RECREATION

Hopewell Community Park is as picturesque as it gets when it comes to parks. The park hosts numerous activities and events for all ages each year and is open to the public. The Park encompasses 78 acres of primarily undeveloped woodlands, fields and wetlands. The park features the Larry Blaney Nature Center, Four Pavilions, Five Hiking/Fitness Trails (approx. 2.35 miles total), toddler and youth playground, restrooms, concession stand, 2-acre stocked lake, handicap accessible fishing pier, picnic areas, paddleboat rentals. The park is staffed all year round with a full time Parks & Recreation Director and a Maintenance staff.


