



HOPEWELL TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE 2019-03

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, FIXING THE TAX RATE REQUIRED TO DEFRAY SPECIFIC EXPENDITURES AND LIABILITIES FOR OPERATION OF HOPEWELL TOWNSHIP GOVERNMENT FOR THE YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31st, 2020.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted according to the power and authority granted under the First Class Township Code, Act of December 14th, 1967, P.L. 819, effective January 1st, 1969.

SECTION 1. That for and during the 2020 calendar year, a tax be and is hereby levied on all property within said Township of Hopewell, subject to taxation for Township purposes at the rate of SIXTEEN mills of each dollar, or the sum of one dollar and sixty cents (\$1.60) on each hundred dollars of assessed valuation.

SECTION 2. That the collection period shall be two percent (2%) Discount from March First through April Thirtieth; Face from May First through June Thirtieth, and Penalty of ten percent (10%) assessed after June Thirtieth.

SECTION 3. That the estimated expenses of Hopewell Township government and the amount appropriated therefore from the revenue estimated to be derived during the calendar year ending December 31st, 2020 are fully set forth in the adopted Budget of Hopewell Township, a copy of which is on file in the office of the Township Manager at the Hopewell Township Municipal Building, 1700 Clark Boulevard, Aliquippa, PA 15001.
