

ORDINANCE NO. 2020-01
TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL
BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, A FIRST CLASS TOWNSHIP UNDER THE LAWS OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE 80-6 IN CONNECTION WITH HOPEWELL COMMUNITY PARK, RELATING TO THE MANAGEMENT THEREOF, PRESCRIBING REGULATIONS FOR THE CONDUCT OF PERSONS WHILE IN SUCH PARK, AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATIONS OF SUCH REGULATIONS.

WHEREAS the Township of Hopewell hereby amends Ordinance 80-6 in connection with the rules and regulations for Hopewell Community Park, relating to the management thereof, prescribing regulations for the conduct of persons while in such park, and prescribing penalties for the violations of such regulations to incorporate the Rules and Regulations attached hereto as Exhibit A which shall supersede any provision of Ordinance 80-6 which is inconsistent herewith.

The rules and regulations may hereafter be amended by resolution of the Township's Board of Commissioners.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell. A municipal corporation under the First Class Township Code situate in Beaver County, Pennsylvania, AND IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED.

Hopewell Park Rules and Regulations

1. Park hours are 8:00am to 10:00pm - Winter 8:00am until dusk
2. No bench or table is to be changed or removed without township approval.
3. Do not deface, injure, remove, cut or damage any of the trees, plants, shrubs, turf, buildings or fixtures.
4. Do not annoy others in the park.
5. No persons or group totaling 10 or more can gather in a park pavilion without a Township permit.
6. Use of shelters by permit only. Each permit requires a deposit and rental fee.
7. **ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES are RESTRICTED.** Alcohol may be consumed if the following condition is met: more food than alcohol is present. Consumption of alcohol by underage persons is illegal and strictly prohibited.
8. The exclusive use of alcohol is not permitted in the park.
9. Do not set up a booth, table or stand for the sale of any articles without written Township consent.
10. No dumping of garbage, waste or litter in the park.
11. Do not deface any posted notice or regulation.
12. Do not place any notice or placard without Township approval.
13. No open fires permitted. Fires only made in stoves or special fireplaces provided. Charcoal or wood fires only. Do not use park wood.
14. No discharging of firearms, archery or any other propelled devices in the park.
15. No hunting or trapping on park property.
16. No unlicensed vehicle, all-terrain vehicle or motorcycle or dirt bike in the park.
17. No pets are allowed in the main park area. Dogs are allowed in the designated Dog Park area only.
18. No swimming, skating or boating in or on the park lake, unless approved by the Township.
19. No sledding in the park.
20. Do not exceed the 5 mph park speed limit. Do not park in the grass or along the park road areas.
21. Do not climb, sit, stand or walk on any tree, sign, building or other park structures.
22. No tents, shacks, shelters, trailers or other overnight camping structures permitted unless approved by the Township.
23. No hobby devices in the park unless approved by the Township.
24. No "live bait" fishing.
25. No inflatable, playground apparatus, live animals or petting zoo will be permitted without prior approval of the Township management.
26. No Table Confetti allowed during any rentals of a pavilion or the Nature Center.
27. All recreation items (Horseshoes and Volleyballs) must be placed back into their box and placed back on the Caretakers porch.

VIOLATIONS: of any of the above rules and regulations shall result, upon conviction, of a fine up to \$300.00 and costs of prosecution for each and every offense.

NOTICE: Please call the Hopewell Township Police Department or the Park Caretaker if you see any violation. Your help and concern will make our Community Park a better place to visit.

PERMIT INFORMATION: All permits required by this ordinance must be posted at specific confines at the park. For a permit or information call the Hopewell Township Municipal Building at 724-378-1460 between the hours of 8:00am to 4:30pm, Monday thru Friday.
