

ORDINANCE 2009-06

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA, FIXING THE TAX RATES TO BE REQUIRED TO DEFRAY SPECIFIC
EXPENDITURES AND LIABILITIES FOR THE OPERATION OF THE TOWNSHIP
GOVERNMENT FOR THE YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2010.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, a Municipal Corporation under the First Class Township Code of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

SECTION 1. That for and during the 2010 calendar year, a tax be and is hereby levied on all property within said Township of Hopewell, subject to taxation for Township purposes at the rate of ELEVEN mills of each dollar, or the sum of one dollar and ten cents (\$1.10) on each hundred dollars, of assessed valuation.

SECTION 2. That the collection period shall be two percent (2%) Discount from March First through April Thirtieth; Face from May First through June Thirtieth, and Penalty of ten percent (10%) assessed after June Thirtieth.

SECTION 3. That the estimated expenses of Township government and the amounts appropriated therefore from the revenue estimated to be derived during the calendar year ending December 31st, 2010 are fully set forth in the adopted Budget of the Township, a copy of which is on file in the office of the Township Manager, at the Municipal Building, 1700 Clark Boulevard, Aliquippa PA 15001.
