Engineer's Report was Discussed, Submitted, and is on File.

6:49 P.M. New Business

Manager, Jamie Yurcina discussed changing from Verizon Wireless to TMobile Wireless resulting in a substantial savings to the Township. We will move forward with the switch over and expect it to be completed by the end of the month.

Mr. Yurcina discussed the jump in prices for the Township recycle bins. We currently charge residents \$10 per bin. The last quote we received reflected a jump to \$15.46 per bin. Mr Yurcina proposed a raise in the price to \$16 each to cover the cost of the bin as well as shipping and administrative charges. A vote on the price increase will take place at the time of the next order.

Manager Jamie Yurcina read a letter from Jodi Janicki, a current intern with Senator Bartolotta, requesting permission to volunteer as an unpaid intern to try to secure grants for the Township. Permission was granted under the direction that all grant applications are cleared with the Township prior to applying.

7:34 P.M. Solicitor Report

Solicitor Mike Jones discussed the Resolution regarding Timber Harvesting and the changes regarding the proper marking of trees at eye level and below stump height and to also prohibit portable sawmills at logging or timber harvesting sites.

Mr. Jones also stated he sent a final warning letter to B&B on Brodhead Rd. about compliance issues. Commissioner Force discussed the fact the customers pull up at night and drop cars off creating the issues. Mr. Jones confirmed B&B has had over a year to address these ongoing problems.

Mike Jones would like to get the Stormwater Management Ordinance provided from HRG on the agenda for adoption at the June 27th, 2022, Business Meeting. He requested we move forward with a motion to advertise the ordinance. This would completely replace the existing grading, excavating, and stormwater management outdated ordinances. The current Grading and Excavating Ordinance is from 1979 and Storm Water Management

Ordinance is from 2004.

Mr. Yurcina added that the Stormwater Ordinance is mandated and must be updated.

Mike Jones also discussed the Turnback Agreement that initially began a couple of months ago and that the document provided from PennDOT was very vague.

Mr. Yurcina explained that Hopewell, Center and Aliquippa must agree to the initial paperwork before it will be put on the table.

Mr. Jones would agree to the wording if the verbiage also included that PennDOT would be assuming responsible for the upgrades. Mr. Jones will make the needed adjustments and get it back to the Board.
