ORDINANCE NO. 56-10

AN ORDINANCE CREATING AND ESTABLISHING IN THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, A TOWNSHIP PLANNING COMMISSION CONSISTING OF FIVE PERSONS TO BE APPOINTED BY THE HOPEWELL TOWNSHIP BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Hopewell Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to the provisions of the Acts of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, approved June 24, 1931, P.L. 1206, Article XXXII, Section 3201, as amended and the Act of May 31, 1933, P.L. 1096, Section 1, as amended, there is hereby created a Township Planning Commission consisting of five persons, all of whom shall be residents of the Township.

SECTION 2. The members of the Commission shall be appointed by the Board of Commissioners, shall serve without compensation, and shall have all the powers and duties conferred upon them by the aforesaid Acts, as amended, and by proper Township ordinances.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance, are hereby repealed.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Hopewell Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to the provisions of the Acts of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, approved June 24, 1931, P. L. 1206, Article XXXII, Section 3201, as amended and the Act of May 31, 1933, P. L. 1096, Section 1, as amended, there is hereby created a Township Planning Commission consisting of five persons, all of whom shall be residents of the Township.

SECTION 2. The members of the Commission shall be appointed by the Board of Commissioners, shall serve without compensation, and shall have all the powers and duties conferred upon them by the aforesaid Acts, as amended, and by proper Township ordinances.
