ORDINANCE NO. 56-3

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE MANNER
OF PAYMENT OF ANY INDEBTEDNESS OF THE
TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL.

Be it enacted and ordained and it is hereby enacted and
ordained as follows:

Section I. That all disbursements and discharge of town-
ship indebtedness and bills paid and duly incurred shall be by
warrant or order consecutively numbered and drawn by order of
the Board of Township Commissioners from the proper appropriation
signed by the President or in his absence the Vice-President and
attested to by the Secretary of the Board of Commissioners and
signed by the Township Treasurer.

sioners assembled this 6th day of February, 1956.

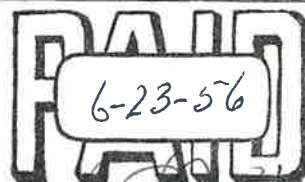
