AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA PROVIDING FOR THE LEVY AND COLLECTION OF A TAX OF \$2.00 PER MONTH OR FRACTIONAL PART THEREOF ON THE USE OR OCCUPATION OF HOUSE TRAILERS SUITABLE FOR LIVING QUARTERS AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES UNDER THE AUTHORITY OF ACT OF JUNE 25, 1947 (PAMPHLET LAWS 1145) AND ITS AMENDMENTS.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Hopewell Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, under the authority of the Act of June 25, 1947, (P.L. 1145) and its amendments, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same:

SECTION 1. A tax is hereby levied for general township purposes on the use and occupancy of house trailers suitable for living quarters in the Township of Hopewell, Beaver County, Pennsylvania at the rate of Two (\$2.00) Dollars per month or fractional part thereof, provided that no tax shall be levied or collected for the first thirty days in the trailer camp or parking lot.

SECTION 2. Said tax shall be collected monthly by the Tax Collector of the Township of Hopewell from the owners of any such house trailers in said Township.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall become effective the first Monday of July, 1956.

SECTION 4. Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be subject to a fine of Twenty-Five (\$25.00) Dollars upon summary conviction before a Justice of the Peace.
