ORDINANCE NO. 57-2

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, SIGNIFYING THE INTENTION OF THE POLITICAL SUBDIVISION TO JOIN WITH OTHER POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS IN THE CREATION OF A REGIONAL PLANNING COMMISSION: PROVIDING FOR THE MEMBERSHIP, TERMS, QUALIFICATIONS AND REPRESENTATION BY THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL ON SAID COMMISSION: AND FURTHER MANIFESTING THE INTENTION OF THE HOPEWELL TOWNSHIP BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION TO THE REGIONAL PLANNING COMMISSION FOR THE YEAR 1957 IN ITS 1957 FISCAL BUDGET.

WHEREAS, the Act of 1955, August 9, P.L. \_\_\_\_ No. 130, Section 2009 being the General County Law as amended, authorizes the association together of political subdivisions in the creation of a Regional Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, by proper resolutions of the Borough of Aliquippa, the Townships of Hopewell and Center have agreed to associate themselves in the creation of a Regional Planning Commission in conformity with the provisions of the Act of 1955, August 9, P.L. \_\_\_\_ No. 130, Section 2009, being the General County Law; and

WHEREAS, the initial number of members of the Regional Planning Commission as herein constituted shall be thirteen (13) members with the participating political subdivisions being represented in the following numbers and for the following initial terms:

Borough of Aliquippa	One member for one year. Two members for two years. Three members for three years.
Township of Hopewell	One member for one year. One member for two years. Two members for three years.
Township of Center	One member for one year. One member for two years. One member for three years.

The representation from each political subdivision shall include not more than one member holding public office excepting appointive membership on a municipal or other Planning Commission. Each member of the Regional Planning Commission shall be twenty-one years of age or over and shall be a resident of his respective political subdivision and shall be eligible for reappointment. The respective political subdivisions shall have the right to appoint and remove respective members to fill any vacancy caused by death, resignation or otherwise, for the unexpired term; and

WHEREAS, any political subdivision shall have the right to withdraw from the Commission at the end of any calendar year by giving three months written notice to the Chairman of said Commission and to the governing bodies of the member political subdivisions; and failure, by a member political subdivision to appropriate for each succeeding year in its current budget shall constitute a withdrawal of said member and said member shall be denied all right of participation on the Commission; and



WHEREAS, in order to consummate the objectives herein mentioned, the aforesaid political subdivisions have deemed it necessary to enact ordinances or resolutions undertaking their responsibilities thereunder.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained and enacted by the Board of Commissioners of Hopewell Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same:

SECTION 1. It is hereby authorized and directed that the Township of Hopewell, a duly incorporated Township of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, does hereby join and associate itself in the creation of a Regional Planning Commission to be known as "THE SOUTHSIDE REGIONAL PLANNING COMMISSION OF BEAVER COUNTY" upon condition in that the Borough of Aliquippa, Township of Hopewell and the Township of Center shall likewise manifest their intentions to join in the creation of said Regional Planning Commission and undertake to enact or pass ordinances or resolutions and make appropriations in conformity with the provisions of this ordinance.

SECTION 2. The Board of Commissioners of Hopewell Township shall appoint as members of the Southside Regional Planning Commission of Beaver County, four persons as follows:

One member to serve one year term, one member to serve two year term and two members to serve three year terms. Upon the expiration of the initial terms, the members shall then be appointed for terms of three years.

SECTION 3. The Board of Commissioners of Hopewell Township does hereby signify its intention to contribute to the expenses of the Southside Regional Planning Commission of Beaver County. The sum to be contributed by the Township of Hopewell and by the other municipalities is to be agreed upon at a future date.

SECTION 4. No other political subdivision other than those named in Section One herein shall be admitted to the Southside Regional Planning Commission of Beaver County except upon such terms and conditions as shall be unanimously agreed upon by the participating political subdivisions.

SECTION 5. The President of the Board of Commissioners and the Secretary of the Township of Hopewell are hereby authorized and directed to execute any agreements or instruments and to perform any and all acts on behalf of the Township of Hopewell necessary to carry out the provisions of this ordinance in conformity with the terms of this ordinance and the applicable Acts of Assembly as made and provided.

ORDAINED AND ENACTED into law by ordinance this 8<sup>th</sup> day of March, 1957.
