ORDINANCE NO. 57-3

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LEVY AND COLLECTION OF AN INSPECTION FEE UPON PUBLIC SERVICE CORPORATIONS FOR SUPERVISION AND INSPECTION OF THE ERECTION, CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE OF POLES, WIRES, CABLES, CONDUITS, GAS PIPES, LINES, MAINS AND CONDUITS USED IN THE CONDUCT OF THE BUSINESS OF THE RESPECTIVE PUBLIC SERVICE CORPORATIONS IN, UNDER, UPON, ALONG OR ABOVE ANY OF THE STREETS, ALLEYS, HIGHWAYS OR PUBLIC PLACES IN THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AND IMPOSING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION.

The Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, hereby enact and ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. The public service corporations enumerated in Section 2 of this ordinance shall pay an annual inspection fee to the Treasurer of Hopewell Township for the supervision and inspection of the erection, construction and maintenance of poles, wires, cables, conduits, gas pipes, lines, mains and conduits used in the conduct of the business of the respective public service corporations, in, under, upon, along or above any of the streets, alleys, highways or public places in the Township of Hopewell.

SECTION 2. (a) All wire using companies shall pay an inspection fee at the rate of fifteen cents (15¢) per mile, per calendar year or fraction thereof, for wires, cables and conduits erected, maintained or used in, under, upon, along or above any of the streets, alleys, highways or public places in the Township of Hopewell.

(b) All wire using companies shall pay an inspection fee at the rate of twenty-five cents (25¢) per pole, per calendar year or fraction thereof, for each pole erected, maintained or used in, on or along any of the streets, alleys, highways or public places in the Township of Hopewell.

(c) All gas companies shall pay an inspection fee at the rate of fifteen cents (15¢) per mile, per calendar year or fraction thereof for gas pipes, lines, mains and conduits erected, laid, maintained or used in, under or along any of the streets, alleys, highways or public places in the Township of Hopewell.

SECTION 3. This ordinance, when enacted, shall be effective as of January 1, 1957.

SECTION 4. Each public service corporation aforesaid shall within thirty (30) days after enactment of this ordinance and annually in January of each year thereafter, certify in writing to the Treasurer and to the Secretary of Hopewell Township, the number of poles and total number of miles of aforesaid facilities in use at the date of certification.

SECTION 5. Each public service corporation aforesaid shall within thirty (30) days after enactment of this ordinance and annually in January of each year thereafter, pay to the Treasurer of Hopewell Township the respective inspection fees as hereinabove provided.

SECTION 6. Any public service corporation owning or maintaining any pole, wire, cable, conduit, gas pipe, line, main or conduit in, under, upon, along or above any of the streets, alleys, highways or public places in the Township of Hopewell and refusing or neglecting to pay the inspection fee imposed under this ordinance shall be subject to a fine or penalty of fifteen cents (15¢) per mile of wire, cable, or conduit, twenty-five cents (25¢) per pole and fifteen cents (15¢) per mile of gas pipe, line, main or conduit, as the case may be, for each month the respective fee remains unpaid beyond the time it is due in accordance with the terms of this ordinance. Such fine or penalty shall be for the use of the Township of Hopewell and shall be collected as fines and penalties are now by law collected.

SECTION 7. All ordinances or parts of prior ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent that they are inconsistent with this ordinance.
