ORDINANCE NO. 58-10

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE CONVEYANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP-OWNED SEWER SYSTEM TO HOPEWELL TOWNSHIP AUTHORITY AND DIRECTING THE PROPER OFFICERS OF THE TOWNSHIP TO MAKE CONVEYANCE.

WHEREAS, Hopewell Township Authority has been created by the Township of Hopewell, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, pursuant to the provisions of the Municipality Authorities Act of 1945, as amended, for the purpose of acquiring, holding, constructing, improving, maintaining, operating, owning, and leasing, either as lessor or lessee, sewers, sewer systems or parts thereof and sewage treatment works, including works for treating and disposing of industrial waste, for the rendering of sewer service to the inhabitants of the Township of Hopewell and such other territory as it may lawfully serve; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire and intention of the Township of Hopewell to transfer to Hopewell Township Authority all right, title and interest of the Township in and to ~~certain portions of~~ its existing sanitary sewer system.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Board of Township ^{Commissioners} ~~Supervisors~~ of the Township of Hopewell by authority of the same as follows:

Section 1. That the Township of Hopewell shall and does hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey, release, confirm, and set over unto Hopewell Township Authority all of the municipally-owned sewer system, together with all other property, real and personal, appurtenant thereto as well as all easements, franchises, licenses and rights held, owned or used or useful by the Township of Hopewell in connection with said sewer system for the price of \$1.00.

Section 2. That the proper officers of the Township of Hopewell be and they are hereby authorized, empowered and directed forthwith upon the enactment of this ordinance and upon its becoming effective by advertisement and recording according to law, do make,

execute and deliver the necessary deed or deeds of conveyance, bill of sale and other legal instruments to effectively carry out the terms of this ordinance.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

ORDAINED AND ENACTED into law by the Board of Township Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell in lawful session regularly assembled this 5th day of May, 1958.

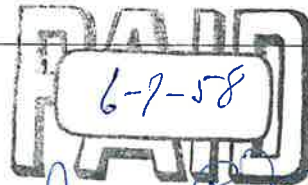
