ORDINANCE NO. 58-13

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL  
COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, PROHIBITING THE  
DUMPING OF GARBAGE OR REFUSE ONTO THE  
ANOTHER OR ONTO OR ALONG ANY ROAD, STREET  
OR ALLEY WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE SAID  
AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of  
Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and it is  
by authority of the same:

Section 1. No person, association, firm or  
throw or dump or cause to be thrown or dumped on  
land of another or onto or along any road, street  
the limits of the said Township.

Section 2. Any person, association, firm or  
shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance  
thereof before any Justice of the Peace be sentenced  
than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) and costs of  
of payment of such fine and costs, to imprisonment  
for not more than thirty (30) days.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Hopewell Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same:

Section 1. No person, association, firm or corporation shall throw or dump or cause to be thrown or dumped any garbage or refuse onto the land of another or onto or along any road, street, highway or alley within the limits of the said Township.

Section 2. Any person, association, firm or corporation who or which shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof before any Justice of the Peace be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) and costs of prosecution, and in default of payment of such fine and costs, to imprisonment in the Beaver County Jail for not more than thirty (30) days.
