Any person, association, firm or corporation who or which shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof before any Justice of the Peace be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) and costs of prosecution, and in default of payment of such fine and costs, to imprisonment in the Beaver County Jail for not more than thirty (30) days.
