ORDINANCE NO. 58-5
AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF
HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A FUND IN THE NAME OF THE
TOWNSHIP TO BE CALLED THE SEWER
SYSTEM FUND; AUTHORIZING CERTAIN
OFFICIALS OF THE TOWNSHIP TO DRAW
CHECKS AND MAKE WITHDRAWALS FROM
SAID FUND.

WHEREAS, the Township of Hopewell, Beaver County, Pennsylvania has entered into an Agreement of Lease, dated as of May 1, 1958, with Hopewell Township Authority whereby the Township has leased from the Authority the Authority's Sewer System; and

WHEREAS, by the terms of said Agreement of Lease the Town-ship has agreed to deposit all revenues derived from the operation of the Sewer System in an account with an authorized depositary separate and distinct from all other accounts of the Township, such special account to be designated the "Sewer System Fund".

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Township Commissioners Township of Hopewell, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same:

Section 1. Economy Bank of Ambridge
be and it hereby is designated as depositary of the funds to be
derived by the Township from the operation of the Sewer System,
which is to be leased by the Township from Hopewell Township Authority, and is authorized to accept for deposit in an account to
be known as the "Sewer System Fund" in the name of the Township,
subject to clearance or collection, moneys, checks, drafts, notes,
bills of exchange, acceptances or other orders for the payment of
money which may at any time come into its possession with or without endorsement thereof by the Township, payment thereof to the
depositary being hereby guaranteed, and said depositary is authorized and directed to honor and pay and to charge to the
accounts of this Township all checks, drafts, bills of exchange,
acceptances, notes or orders for the payment of money withdrawn

on or addressed to said depositary and signed on behalf of this Township by the following officers:

or their successors in the particular offices named whether the same be payable to the order of or in favor of the officer or person signing them, or to any of said officers in his individual capacity or otherwise.

Section 2. The words used herein which are defined in the Agreement of Lease, dated as of May 1, 1958, between Hopewell Township Authority and the Township of Hopewell are used with the meaning as so defined.

Section 3. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon final enactment.
