Section 2. The Chief of Police shall be appointed by the Board of Commissioners and shall have supervision over its members in the exercise of their police powers, duties and authority.

Section 3. The Chief of Police and policemen are to obey the orders of the Board of Township Commissioners.

Section 4. Nothing herein contained shall effect the authority of the Board of Township Commissioners to appoint special policemen during emergencies.
