Bonding Excavations

ORDINANCE NO. 59-4

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA PROVIDING FOR THE BONDING AND LICENSING OF EXCAVATORS ENGAGED IN INSTALLING CONNECTIONS TO THE HOPEWELL TOWNSHIP SANITARY SEWER SYSTEM.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Commissioners of Hopewell Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same as follows:

SECTION I LICENSING

Installation, repair or cleaning of lot sewage disposal facilities connecting with the Township Sanitary Sewer System, when done for consideration, shall be performed only on the obtaining of a license issued upon application, by the Township Secretary for a fee of \$25.00. Licenses shall be for a one year period and may be renewed from year to year upon the payment of a fee of \$25.00. Licenses may be revoked or suspended for cause by the Board of Commissioners.

SECTION II BONDING

Any person, firm, association, partnership, or corporation, engaging in the installation, repair, or cleaning of connections to the Hopewell Township Sanitary Sewer System shall prior to applying for a license required by Section I above, furnish a surety bond in the sum of \$5,000.00 with suitable reasonable requirements guaranteeing the proper installation of a sewer connections in conformity with federal, state and local municipal legislation, and further guaranteeing of the proper restoration of streets, roads, highways and drainage ditches disturbed or excavated in the process of installations. Connections to trunk lines where wye's do not exist are to be made only by qualified personnel.

SECTION III EXPENSES OF RE-INSPECTION

In the event that it is necessary for the Township Sewer Inspector to make more than one trip to the site of an excavation to inspect same, the excavator shall be obligated to pay to

Hopewell Township a fee of \$1.00 for each additional trip so made.

SECTION IV PENALTY

Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall upon conviction thereof before any Justice of the Peace be subject to a fine of not more than \$50.00 for each offense, and in default of payment of said fine and cost of prosecution, shall be imprisoned for a period not exceeding 30 days.

SECTION V REPEALER

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Commissioners of Hopewell Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1. LICENSING

SECTION 2. BONDING

SECTION 3. EXPENSES OF RE-INSPECTION

In the event that it is necessary for the Township Sewer Inspector to make more than one trip to the site of an excavation to inspect same, the excavator shall be obligated to pay to Hopewell Township a fee of \$1.00 for each additional trip so made.

SECTION 4. PENALTY
Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall upon conviction thereof before any Justice of the Peace be subject to a fine of not more than \$50.00 for each offense and in default of payment of said fine and cost of prosecution, shall be imprisoned for a period not exceeding 30 days.

SECTION 5. REPEALER
All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
