AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING MAXIMUM WEIGHT LIMITS FOR ALL VEHICLES TRAVELING CERTAIN TOWNSHIP ROADS AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Commissioners of Hopewell Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same:

Section 1. Definitions and Interpretations. Words and phrases, when used in this Ordinance, shall have the meanings ascribed to them in the Vehicle Code of Pennsylvania, as now in force, or as hereafter amended, enacted or reenacted.

Section 2. The use of all Township roads in Hopewell Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, as said roads are named and designated in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made part hereof and on file in the office of the Township Secretary, is hereby restricted to vehicles with a gross weight of vehicle and load not in excess of ten (10) tons.

Section 3. Special permits for loads in excess of the limitations set forth herein may be issued by the Board of Commissioners or Police Department in accordance with regulations established from time to time by the Board of Commissioners.

Section 4. Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon summary conviction before a justice of the peace, be sentenced to pay a fine in the amount of not less than Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars nor more than One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars and costs of prosecution, and in default of payment of such fine and costs, to undergo imprisonment for a period not exceeding ten (10) days, or both.
