Compensation for Treasurer tax collector 2/13/1941 ordinance no. 61-3

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH THE COMPENSATION OF THE TREASURER AND TAX COLLECTOR OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell, Beaver County, Pennsylvania:

Section 1. That the compensation of the Township Treasurer for his duties as Treasurer and Tax Collector for the Township of Hopewell shall be a sum equal to two (2%) per centum of all the Township taxes received or collected by him at discount; five (5%) per centum of the taxes received or collected by him at face and penalty; two (2%) per centum of all fire hydrant annual rental charges, and in addition thereto one (1%) per centum of all other money received or collected by him on behalf of the Township, exclusive of any sewer rental charges or other monies received or collected by him in any way relating to the Hopewell Township Sewer System.

Section 2. All ordinances, resolutions or motions heretofore adopted and enacted inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed and withdrawn.

Section 3. This ordinance shall become effective on January 1, 1962.
