ORDINANCE NO. 6/-8

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 56-11 OF THE PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 50-11 OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, PROHIBITING ANY CHILD UNDER SIXTEEN (16) YEARS OF AGE, UNLESS ACCOMPANIED AS HEREIN PROVIDED, TO BE IN OR UPON ANY HIGHWAY, PLAYGROUND, PARK OR OTHER PUBLIC PLACE IN THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL BETWEEN CERTAIN HOURS, DEFINING DUTIES OF PARENTS OR OTHER LEGAL CUSTODIANS OF SUCH CHILDREN AND IMPOSING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS OPDINANCE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Hopewell Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same, that Section 1 of Ordinance No. 56-11 is hereby amended to read as follows:

It shall be unlawful for any child under the SECTION 1. age of sixteen (16) years to be or remain in or upon any public highway, playground, park, or other public place, or in any enclosure or vehicle which is on or in close proximity to any such public place, between the hours of nine (9) o'clock P.M. and five (5) o'clock A.M. during the months of January, February, March, April, May, September, October, November and December and between the hours of ten (10) o'clock P.M. and five (5) o'clock A.M. during the months of June, July and August, unless such child shall be accompanied by a parent, guardian or other person having the legal care or custody of such child, or unless such child be lawfully employed so as to make it necessary to use public highways during employed so as to make it necessary to use public highways during such time for the exclusive use of such employment, provided such child shall have a certificate to that effect signed by the Secretary of Hopewell Township.

That all ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent or conflicting with the provisions of this ordinance and amendment be and the same are hereby repealed.
