ORDINANCE NO. 62-2

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 58-9 OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF SEWER SERVICE CHARGES AND REGULATIONS WITH RESPECT THERETO TO BE COLLECTED FROM AND FOLLOWED BY THE USERS OF THE SEWER SYSTEM OPERATED BY THE TOWNSHIP PURSUANT TO THE TERMS OF A LEASE AGREEMENT ENTERED INTO WITH HOPEWELL TOWNSHIP AUTHORITY.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Hopewell Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same, that Paragraph B, Section II of Exhibit "A" of Ordinance No. 58-9 is hereby amended to add the following numbered paragraph to read:

"9. Sewer rentals for commercial self-service automatic laundry facilities, generally referred to as laundramats, shall be computed on the basis of \$1.40 per quarter per rated pound capacity of the total number of self-service laundry machines that are available for use for any period during the quarter immediately preceeding the billing. All billing for this type of sewer rental shall be rendered quarterly and shall be subject to a five (5) per cent penalty if not paid within ten (10) days from the date of billing. This basis of sewer rental charge shall be in lieu of the metered water use basis stipulated in Paragraph B, Section II of Exhibit "A" of Ordinance No. 58-9 pertaining to commercial establishments. In the event that there are other waste producing sources within the same building in which the self-service laundry machines are situated, sewer rentals for these other waste producing sources will still be based on metered water use and/or other minimum charge bases which may pertain."

All ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent or conflicting with the provisions of this ordinance and amendment be and the same are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final enactment.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 58-9 OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF SEWER SERVICE CHARGES AND REGULATIONS WITH RESPECT THERETO TO BE COLLECTED FROM AND FOLLOWED BY THE USERS OF THE SEWER SYSTEM OPERATED BY THE TOWNSHIP PURSUANT TO THE TERMS OF A LEASE AGREEMENT ENTERED INTO WITH HOPEWELL TOWNSHIP AUTHORITY.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Hopewell Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same, that Paragraph B, Section II of Exhibit "A" of Ordinance No. 58-9 is hereby amended to add the following numbered paragraph to read:

"9. Sewer rentals for commercial self-service automatic laundry facilities, generally referred to as laundromats, shall be computed on the basis of \$1.40 per quarter per rated pound capacity of the total number of self-service laundry machines that are available for use for any period during the quarter immediately preceding the billing. All billing for this type of sewer rental shall be rendered quarterly and shall be subject to a five (5) per cent penalty if not paid within ten (10) days from the date of billing. This basis of sewer rental charge shall be in lieu of Exhibit "A" of Ordinance No. 58-9 pertaining to commercial establishments. In the event that there are other waste producing sources within the same building in which the self-service laundry machines are situated, sewer rentals for these other waste producing sources will still be based on metered water use and/or other minimum charge bases which may pertain.

All ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent or conflicting with the provisions of this ordinance and amendment be and the same are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final enactment.
