AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER
COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 58-3
OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, BEING AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING A TAX UNDER
THE AUTHORITY OF THE ACT OF JUNE 25, 1947 P.L. 1145
AND ITS AMENDMENTS, FOR GENERAL REVENUE PURPOSES
ON SALARIES, WAGES, COMMISSIONS AND OTHER COMPENSATION EARNED DURING THE PERIOD BEGINNING APRIL 1,
1958 AND ENDING DECEMBER 31, 1958 BY RESIDENTS OF
THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, AND ON SALARIES, WAGES,
COMMISSIONS AND OTHER COMPENSATION BARNED DURING
SAID PERIOD BY NON-RESIDENTS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF
HOPEWELL FOR WORK DONE OR SERVICES PERFORMED OR
RENDERED IN THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL AND ON THE NET
PROFITS EARNED DURING SAID PERIOD, FROM BUSINESSES,
PROFESSIONS OR OTHER ACTIVITIES CONDUCTED BY SUCH
RESIDENTS, AND ON THE NET PROFITS BARNED DURING
SAID PERIOD FROM BUSINESSES, PROFESSIONS OR OTHER
ACTIVITIES CONDUCTED IN THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL
BY NON-RESIDENTS; REQUIRING THE FILING OF RETURNS
AND THE GIVING OF INFORMATION BY EMPLOYERS AND
THOSE SUBJECT TO THE SAID TAX; IMPOSING ON EMPLOYERS
THE DUTY OF COLLECTING THE TAX AT SOURCE; PROVIDING
FOR THE ADMINISTRATION AND ENFORCEMENT OF THE
OCCUPANNICE AND IMPOSING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION
THEREOF; AND CONFERRING AND IMPOSING POWERS AND
DUTIES ON THE COLLECTOR OF HOPEWELL TOWNSHIP.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Hopewell Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same, that Ordinance No. 58-3 is hereby amended as follows:

Section 1. That Section 2 (k) of said ordinance which reads as follows:

"Collector" shall mean the official designated by the Board of Commissioners of Hopewell Township to collect the tax imposed by this ordinance and to administer provisions thereof. shall be and is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Collector" shall mean the agent designated by the Board of Commissioners of Hopewell Township to collect the tax imposed by this ordinance and to administer provisions thereof.

Section 2. That Section 6 of said ordinance dealing with declarations is hereby repealed.

Section 3. That all ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent or conflicting with the provisions of this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.
