ORDINANCE NO. 62-6

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, VACATING AN UNNAMED, UNOPENED ALLEY IN THE COCHRAN ACRES PLAN OF LOTS IN SAID TOWNSHIP AS RECORDED IN PLAN BOOK VOL. 6, PAGES 60 & 61.

WHEREAS, after public hearing at the Hopewell Township Municipal Building, Hopewell Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania on June 25, 1962, pursuant to notice required by Section 2007 of the First Class Township Law, the Board of Commissioners of Hopewell Township on July 10, 1962 filed its Report in the Court of Quarter Sessions of Beaver County, Pennsylvania at No. 5 May Sessions, 1962, approving the vacation of the following unnamed, unopened alley as set out in the Cochran Acres Plan of Lots, situate in said Township and recorded in the Recorder's Office of Beaver County in Plan Book Vol. 6, pages 60 and 61.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Hopewell Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same:

Section 1. That the following unnamed, unopened alley as set out in the Cochran Acres Plan of Lots, situate in Hopewell Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania and recorded in the Recorder's Office of Beaver County, in Plan Book Vol. 6, pages 60 and 61, be and the same is hereby vacated:

BEGINNING at a point on the northwesterly side of Ensign Drive, formerly Ridge Avenue, as shown on the Cochran Acres Plan of Lots recorded in the Recorder's Office at Beaver in Plan Book Vol. 6, pages 60 and 61, at the intersection of the easterly line of Lot No. 61 in said Plan with the said side of Ensign Drive; thence along said line of said Lot No. 61, North 54° 23° 30" West, a distance of 150 feet to the southeasterly side of a 20 foot alley as shown on said Plan; thence along said side of said unopened alley, North 35° 36° 30" East, a distance of 20 feet to the westerly line of Lot No. 60 in said Plan; thence along said line of said Lot No. 60, South 54° 23° 30" East, a distance of 150 feet to the northwesterly side of Ensign Drive aforesaid; thence along said side of said Drive, South 35° 36° 30" West, a distance of 20 feet to a point, the place of beginning.

SUBJECT, however, to the Right-of-Way for the existing sewer line now crossing the aforesaid tract of land and any structure erected on said land to be at the risk of the owner or owners thereof in case access to said sewer line is necessary.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall become effective on the earliest date provided by law.

Section 3. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.
