ORDINANCE NO. 6

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP  
BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA,  
AND ADOPTING CERTAIN STREETS  
THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL AS  
OR ROADS.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board  
the Township of Hopewell, Beaver County  
hereby ordained and enacted by authority

Section 1. The following streets and  
Estates Plan No. 1; Plan No. 2; Plan No.  
Plan No. 2-Revision; Plan No. 3, Blocks  
Block D; Plan No. 3, Blocks E, F, G and P  
the Recorder's Office of Beaver County  
174 and 175; Vol. 8, page 68; Vol. 8, pa  
page 168; Vol. 9, pages 24 and 25; Vol.  
taken over and adopted as public street  
of Hopewell, Beaver County, Pennsylvania

(a) Goodnow Street, having a 40 foot  
grades, from end of pavement to McIntosh  
approximately .04 of a mile. (Note: C  
2 (g) adopted first portion of Goodnow  
to its end, a distance of .06 of a mile

(b) Schell Circle, having a 40 foot  
grades, from McIntosh Drive to the end  
of approximately .16 of a mile;

(c) McIntosh Drive, having a 50 foot  
ing grades, from Goodnow Street to Mart  
approximately .09 of a mile.

Section 2. The following streets and  
Plan Extension to Plan No. 2, as recorded  
Office of Beaver County in Plan Book V

Section 3. The following streets and roads in White Oaks Plan of Lots, as recorded in the Recorder's Office of Beaver County, in Plan Book Vol. 9, pages 182 and 183, are hereby taken over and adopted as public streets or roads in the Township of Hopewell, Beaver County, Pennsylvania:

(a) Parkridge Drive, having a 40 foot right-of-way, at existing grades, from Crestmont Village 3rd Addition Plan to the end at cul-de-sac, a distance of approximately .11 of a mile;

(b) Wedgewood Oval, having a 40 foot right-of-way, at existing grades, from Parkridge Drive to the end at cul-de-sac, a distance of approximately .04 of a mile.

Section 4. The following street or road in the Edgewood Manor Plan 1, as recorded in the Recorder's Office of Beaver County in Plan Book Vol. 9, page 138 is hereby taken over and adopted as a public street or road in the Township of Hopewell, Beaver County, Pennsylvania:

(a) Beverly Drive, having a 40 foot right-of-way, at existing grades, from Brodhead Road to the end at cul-de-sac, a distance of approximately .19 of a mile.
