ORDINANCE NO. 63-15

AN ORDINANCE ALENDING ORDINANCE NO. 58-9 ELITITED "AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF SEWER SERVICE CHARGES AND REGULATIONS WITH RESPECT THERETO TO BE COLLECTED FROM AND FOLLOWED BY THE USERS OF THE SEWER SYSTEM OPERATED BY THE TOWNSHIP PURSUANT TO THE TERMS OF A LEASE AGREEMENT ENTERED INTO WITH HOPEWELL TOWNSHIP AUTHORITY" BY PROVIDING FOR THE REDUCTION OF SCHOOL AND NON-RESIDENTIAL SEWER RENTAL RATES.

BE IT CROAINED AND MNACTED by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same as follows:

Section 1. That portion of Hopewell Township Ordinance No. 58-9, Exhibit "A" Sewer System Connection Charges, Sewer Rentals and Regulations, Section II, B. 1., Hon-Residential, which in part reads as follows:

"All sewer rentals based upon water consumption shall be computed at a rate of \$1.50 per 1000 galions per quarter." be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"All sewer rentals based upon water consumption shall be computed at a rate of \$1.20 per 1000 gallons per quarter."

Section 2. That portion of Hopewell Township Ordinance No. 58-9, Exhibit "A" Sewer System Connection Charges, Sewer Rentals and Regulations, Section II, B. 7., Non-Residential, which in part reads as follows:

"The sewer rental to schools shall be not less than seventyfive cents (\$.75) per pupil per quarter." be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"The sewer rental to schools shall be not less than sixty cents (\$.60) per pupil per quarter."

Section 3. The provisions of this Ordinance shall become effective January 1, 1964.
