ORDINANCE NO. 63-17

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, TAKING OVER AND ADOPTING CERTAIN STREETS AND ROADS IN THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL AS PUBLIC STREETS OR ROADS.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same:

Section 1. The following street or road in the Laird Plan of Lots as recorded in the Recorder's Office of Beaver County in Plan Book Vol. 5, page 109 is hereby taken over and adopted as a public street or road in the Township of Hopewell, Beaver County, Pennsylvania:

(a) Laird Avenue, having a 40 foot right-of-way, at existing grades, from Route 51 (Brodhead Road) to Maratta Road, a distance of approximately .20 of a mile.

Section 2. The following streets or roads in the Hannah A. Creese Plan of Lots Section "A" and the Hannah A. Creese Heirs Plan, Section "B", as recorded in the Recorder's Office of Beaver County in Plan Book Vol. 5, page 49 and Vol. 6, pages 56 and 57, are hereby taken over and adopted as public streets or roads in the Township of Hopewell, Beaver County, Pennsylvania:

(a) McConnell Street, formerly Chestnut Street, having a 35 foot right-of-way, at existing grades, from School Street to the end of existing dedication, a distance of .20 of a mile;

(b) Juanita Street, having a 35 foot right-of-way, at existing grades, from Creese Street to the end of existing dedication, a distance of .18 of a mile;

(c) Elizabeth Street, having a 35 foot right-of-way, at existing grades, from McConnell Street to Juanita Street, a distance of .06 of a mile.

Section 3. The following street or road in the Gringo Terrace Plan of Lots, as recorded in the Recorder's Office of Beaver County in Plan Book Vol. 5, page 31 is hereby taken over and adopted as a public street or road in the Township of Hopewell, Beaver County, Pennsylvania:

(a) Kinney Drive, having a 50 foot right-of-way, at existing grades, from Route 151 (Gringo Road) to the end of existing dedication, a distance of .28 of a mile.

Section 4. The following streets or roads in the Davidson Heights Plan of Lots, as recorded in the Recorder's Office of Beaver County in Plan Book Vol. 5, page 58 are hereby taken over and adopted as public streets or roads in the Township of Hopewell, Beaver County, Pennsylvania:

(a) Allen Street, having a 40 foot right-of-way, at existing

grades, from Anderson Avenue to end of existing dedication thus far paved, a distance of .11 of a mile;

(b) Anderson Avenue, having a 40 foot right-of-way, at existing grades, from a point being North 6° 20' East a distance of 99.5 feet from the intersection of the centerline of Maratta Road and said Anderson Avenue, to the end of existing dedication thus far paved, a distance of .03 of a mile.
