ORDINANCE NO. 63-8

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 63-5 OF HOPWELL TOWNSHIP, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ORDAINED AND ENACTED ON THE FIFTH DAY OF JUNE, 1963 AMENDING AND APPROVING THE CHARGE OF THE COST OF CONSTRUCTION BY THE HOPWELL TOWNSHIP AUTHORITY AGAINST THE PROPERTIES BENEFITED, IMPROVED OR ACCOMMODATED THEREBY ACCORDING TO THE FOOT FRONT RULE.

WHEREAS, the Township of Hopewell, Beaver County, Pennsylvania ordained and enacted an Ordinance No. 63-5 on the fifth day of June, 1963 and

WHEREAS, by the provisions of Section 5 of said Ordinance, the Hopewell Township Authority proposal to assess \$165,000 of the cost of construction of the assessable portions of the capital additions and extensions, to the sewer system fund against the properties benefited, improved or accommodated thereby according to the foot front rule at \$6.90 per front foot, and

WHEREAS, since the enactment of that Ordinance, the Hopewell Township Authority has received firm bids for the construction of the capital addition and extension to the Sanitary Sewer System, and

WHEREAS, said Firm bids were less than the estimated cost, and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Board of Township Commissioners to make the necessary adjustments in the gross amount of the assessment, and in the amount per front foot;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY the Commissioners of Hopewell Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by Authority of the same:

Section 1. That Section 5 of Ordinance 63-5 which read as follows:

Section 5. The proposal of Hopewell Township Authority to assess \$165,000 of the cost of construction of the assessable portions of the capital addition and extensions, including lateral and service connections,

force mains, and pumping stations, to the sewer system against the properties benefited, improved or accommodated thereby according to the foot front rule at \$6.90 per front foot with provisions for equitable adjustment for corner and odd shaped lots. is hereby amended, ordained and enacted as follows:

Section 2. The proposal of Hopewell Township Authority to assess \$ 135,000 of the cost of construction of the assessable portions of the capital addition and extensions, including lateral and service connections, force mains, and pumping stations, to the sewer system against the properties benefited, improved or accommodated thereby according to the foot front rule at \$5.45 per front foot with provisions for equitable adjustment for corner and odd shaped lots is hereby approved.

Section 3. All other Ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed insofar as the same conflict herewith.

ORDAINED AND ENACTED FINALLY into law by the Board of Township Commissioners this 22nd day of August, 1963.
