## ORDINANCE NO. 64-3

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, PROVIDING FOR AND REQUIRING THE CONSTRUCTION OF CONCRETE CURBS ON MEADOW DRIVE IN THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA AND ASSESSING THE FULL COST OF SAID CONCRETE CURBS ON THE OWNERS OF REAL ESTATE ABUTTING THEREON ACCORDING TO THE FOOT FRONT RULE.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Commissioners of Hopewell Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same:

Section 1. The Township of Hopewell shall cause to be constructed concrete curbs on Meadow Drive from Maratta Road to the end of said Meadow Drive in accordance with plans and specifications prepared by the Township Engineer and on file in the office of the Township Secretary.

Section 2. The costs and expenses of said concrete curbs shall be paid by the owners of real estate bounding or abutting thereon, and the same is hereby assessed according to the foot front rule, and the assessments appropriated therefore out of funds now or hereafter in the Township Treasury. The Township Engineer is hereby designated as the person to estimate the assessments, costs and expenses of said improvements for and on behalf of the Township.

Section 3. The Township Secretary shall give sixty (60) days notice of the assessment to each party assessed which notice shall be served in the manner provided by law.

Section 4. Any assessment authorized under this ordinance shall be paid either in full, within sixty (60) days after notice of such assessment shall have been given to the party assessed as provided by law, or in two (2) equal semi-annual installments, the first of which shall be due and payable within sixty (60) days after such notice. All such installments shall bear interest at the rate of six percentum (6%) commencing sixty (60) days after

the notice of the total assessment. All assessments, whether paid in full or in two installments, shall be payable to the Township Secretary.

Section 5. If any assessment authorized under this ordinance shall not have been paid in full or if an installment payment of one-half the total amount of such assessment shall not have been made within sixty (60) days after notice, the entire assessment shall be due, and it shall be the duty of the Township Solicitor to collect the same, with interest at the rate of six percentum (6%) commencing sixty (60) days after notice of the total assessment, by action of assumpsit or by a lien to be filed and collected in the same manner as municipal claims.

Section 6. Any ordinance or parts of an ordinance conflicting with the provisions of this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed in so far as the same conflict with this ordinance.
