Ordinance 64-6 Subdivision of Land 9/14/1964

## ordinance no. 64-6

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ARTICLE IX, SECTION 800 OF ORDINANCE NO. 58-12 KNOWN AS HOPEWELL TOWNSHIP RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE SUBDIVISION OF LAND.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Commissioners of Hopewell Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same:

1. That Article IX, Section 800 of Ordinance No. 58-12, known as Hopewell Township Rules and Regulations for the Subdivision of Land which reads as follows:

"Any person, co-partnership or corporation, who or which shall subdivide any lot, tract or parcel of land, layout, construct, open or dedicate any street, sanitary sewer, storm sewer or water main, for public use of travel, or for the common use of occupants of buildings abutting thereon, sell any lot, erect any building in a subdivision without having first complied with the provisions hereof, and the subdivisions adopted hereunder, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof such person or members of such co-partnership or the officers of such corporation responsible for such violation shall be sentenced to suffer imprisonment not exceeding two years or pay a fine not exceeding one thousand dollars, or both, in the discretion of the court."

"Any owner, agent or broker, person, co-partnership or corporation who or which shall subdivide any lot, tract or parcel of land, layout, construct, open or dedicate any street, sanitary sewer, storm sewer or water main, for public use or travel, or or the common use of occupants of buildings abutting thereon, sellany lot, erect any building in a subdivision without having first complied with the provisions hereof, and the subdivisions adopted hereunder, shall be suilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof such owner, agent or broker, person, members of such co-partnership or the officers of such corporation responsible for such violation shall be sentenced to suffer imprisonment not acceding two years or pay a fine not exceeding one thousand dollar, or both, in the discretion of the court."

- 2. The provisions of this ordinance shall be severable and if any of the provisions shall be held to be unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the validity of any of the remaining provisions of the ordinance.
- 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
