ORDINANCE NO. 64-7

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, TAKING OVER AND ADOPTING CERTAIN STREETS AND ROADS IN THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL AS PUBLIC STREETS OR ROADS.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same:

Section 1. The following streets or roads in the Barrett Plan of Lots as recorded in the Recorder's Office of Beaver County in Plan Book Vol. 11, page 47 are hereby taken over and adopted as public streets or roads in the Township of Hopewell, Beaver County, Pennsylvania:

(a) Lantern Lane, having a 40 foot right-of-way, at existing grades, from Woodbine Street to turnaround, a distance of approximately .12 of a mile.

(b) Wigwam Road, having a 40 foot right-of-way, at existing grades, from the Brodhead Road to the intersection with lot line dividing Lots 80 and 81 in said Plan, a distance of .19 of a mile.

(c) Wimpole Street, having a 40 foot right-of-way, at existing grades, from lot line dividing Lots 86 and 87 to the center of Lot No. 121 in said Plan, a distance of .21 of a mile.

Section 2. The following street or road in the Revision of Hillcrest Plan of Lots as recorded in the Recorder's Office of Beaver County in Plan Book Vol. 4, page 55 is hereby taken over and adopted as a public street or road in the Township of Hopewell, Beaver County, Pennsylvania:

(a) Smith Avenue, having a 25 foot right-of-way, at existing grades, from the Brodhead Road to the end, a distance of .07 of a mile.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same:

Section 1. The following streets or roads in the Barrett Plan of Lots as recorded in the Recorder's Office of Beaver County in Plan Book Vol. 11, page 47 are hereby taken over and adopted as public streets or roads in the Township of Hopewell, Beaver County, Pennsylvania:

(a) Lantern Lane, having a 40 foot right-of-way, at existing grades, from Woodbine Street to turnaround, a distance of approximately .12 of a mile.

(b) Wigwam Road, having a 40 foot right-of-way, at existing grades, from the Brodhead Road to the intersection with lot line dividing Lots 80 and 81 in said Plan, a distance of .19 of a mile.

(c) Wimpole Street, having a 40 foot right-of-way, at existing grades, from lot line dividing Lots 86 and 87 to the center of Lot. No. 121 in said Plan, a distance of .21 of a mile.

Section 2. The following street or road in the Revision of Hillcrest Plan of Lots as recorded in the Recorder's Office of Beaver County in Plan Book Vol. 4, page 55 is hereby taken over and adopted as a public street or road in the Township of Hopewell, Beaver County, Pennsylvania:

(a) Smith Avenue, having a 25 foot right-of-way, at existing grades, from the Brodhead Road to the end, a distance of .07 of a mile.
