AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, VACATING TWO PORTIONS OF THE CUL-DE-SAC OF VICTOR CIRCLE IN THE CLEARVIEW ESTATES PLAN OF LOTS NO. 3, IN SAID TOWNSHIP.

WHEREAS, after public hearing at the Hopewell Township
Municipal Building, Hopewell Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania
on October 19, 1964, pursuant to notice required by Section 2007
of the First Class Township Law, the Board of Commissioners of
Hopewell Township, on October 29, 1964, filed its Report in the
Court of Quarter Sessions of Beaver County, Pennsylvania at No. 2
August Sessions, 1964, approving the vacation of two portions of
the unopened cul-de-sac of Victor Circle, in the Clearview
Estates Plan of Lots No. 3, in said Township as said plan is
recorded in Plan Book Vol. 9, pages 110 and 111.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Hopewell Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same:

Section 1. That the following portions of the unopened cul-de-sac of Victor Circle, in the Clearview Estates Plan of Lots No. 3 in said Township as said plan is recorded in Plan Book Vol. 9, pages 110 and 111, be and the same are hereby vacated:

ALL those two certain parts or parcels of ground situate in the Clearview Estates Plan of Lots No. 3, in the Township of Hopewell, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, as recorded in Plan Book Vol. 9, pages 110 and 111, more particularly bounded and described as follows:

Parcel No. 1 BEGINNING at a point on the westerly line of Victor Circle, 14.03 feet South from the intersection of the dividing line between Lots No. 212 and 213 with the werterly line of Victor Circle; thence from said beginning point by a curve to the left having a radius of 40 feet an arc distance of 83.78 feet to a point; thence North 09 degrees 01 minute 13 seconds East, 69.28 feet to the place of beginning.

Parcel No. 2 BEGINNING at a point on the easterly line of Victor Circle, 44.03 feet South from the intersection of the dividing line between Lots No. 211 and 210 with the easterly line of Victor Circle; thence from said beginning point by a curve to the right having a radius of 40 feet an arc distance of 83.78 feet to a point; thence North 09 degrees 01 minute 13 seconds East, 69.28 feet to the place of beginning.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall become effective on the earlies date provided by law.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.

ORDAINED AND ENACTED into an Ordinance this 14th day of December, 1964.


