## ORDINANCE NO. 65-3

AN ORDINANCE OF HOPEWELL TOWNSHIP, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, APPROVING THE CONSTRUCTION AND ESTIMATED COST OF A TREATMENT PLANT, A PUMP STATION, AND IMPROVEMENTS TO THE EXISTING SEWERS IN THE WICKHAM PLAN BY HOPEWELL TOWNSHIP AUTHORITY.

WHEREAS, design drawings for the construction of a sewage treatment plant, a pump station, and improvements to the existing sewers in the Wickham Plan, situate in Hopewell Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, have been prepared by Duncan, Lagnese & Associates, Inc., and have been presented by the Hopewell Township Authority to the Board of Commissioners of Hopewell Township, and

WHEREAS, the said design drawings have been approved by the Sanitary Water Board of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and

WHEREAS, the said Municipal Authority estimates that the cost of construction will be One hundred thousand (\$150,000,000) Dollars, and

WHEREAS, the Act of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania of May 2, 1945, P.L. 382, as amended, requires that the Commissioners of Hopewell Township approve the plans and estimated cost of construction.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Commissioners of Hopewell Township, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Authority of the same:

Section 1. The plan of construction of the sewage treatment plant, a pump station, and improvements to the existing sewers in the Wickham Plan as set forth in the report of Duncan, Lagnese & Associates, Inc., and as shown on design drawings of Duncan, Lagnese & Associates, Inc., is hereby approved.

Section 2. The Secretary of the Township shall keep on file at the principal office of the Township, a copy of said engineering reports and

design drawings where they shall be open to inspection at all reasonable times.

Section 3. The construction of said sewage treatment plant, a pump station, and improvements to the existing sewers in the Wickham Plan with necessary manholes and other appurtenances is hereby approved at a cost not to exceed \$150,000.

Section 4. Should any section or provision of this Ordinance be declared by any Court having jurisdiction, to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole or any part thereof other than the part so declared to be invalid.

ORDAINED AND ENACTED finally into law by the Board of Township Commissioners this 10th day of May, 1965.
