ORDINANCE NO. 65-8

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING THE OFFICIAL ZONING ORDINANCE MAP OF HOPEWELL TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE NO. 61-10 KNOWN AS HOPEWELL TOWNSHIP ZONING ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Commissioners of Hopewell Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same:

1. That the "Official Zoning Ordinance Map" contained and referred to in Hopewell Township Zoning Ordinance No. 61-10 known as Hopewell Township Zoning Ordinance is hereby amended as follows:

"All those three certain lots of land known as Lots Nos. 83, 84 and 85 as designed on J. A. Newell's Second Addition known as New Sheffield Plan of Lots in Hopewell Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania as said plan is recorded in the Recorder's office of Beaver County in Plan Book Volume 3, page 72, shall be re-zoned from "R-3" General Residential to "C-2" Roadside Commercial." Said property described above may be otherwise identified as tax tax reference numbers 866 and 867 on Beaver County Tax Map No. 65-08, revised March 5, 1963.

- 2. The provisions of this ordinance shall be severable and if any of the provisions shall be held to be unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the validity of any of the remaining provisions of the ordinance.
- 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
