## ORDINANCE NO. 66-2

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 56-4, AS AMENDED, ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, REGULATING THE CONSTRUCTION, RECONSTRUCTION, ENLARGEMENT, ALTERATION OR REMOVAL OF BUILDINGS OR STRUCTURES, PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUING OF A PERMIT THEREFORE, AND INSPECTION THEREOF, AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR THE VICLATION OF THIS CRDINANCE."

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Commissioners of Hopewell Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same:

1. That Section 4 of Ordinance No. 56-4 as amended by Ordinance No. 58-15, which reads as follows:

"The fee for issuing such permit or permits shall be the sum of Five Dollars (\$5.00) for a garage, the sum of Two Dollars Fifty Cents (\$2.50) for an addition thereto, the sum of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) for a residence or dwelling, the sum of Five Dollars (\$5.00) for an addition thereto, and the sum of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for any building or structure where any portion of the whole thereof is built or constructed for commercial use, and an additional sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) for each time the plans and specifications are subsequently submitted to the Township Secretary, which said fees shall be paid to the Township Secretary by the applicant at the time the application or reapplication is made. The Township Secretary shall provide a suitable book for the purpose of keeping a record of all permits issued by him, and shall pay to the Township Treasurer all moneys received by him within the month for which the same are received, and shall make monthly reports to the Township Board of Commissioners of all permits issued, the amounts received therefor, together with his receipt from the Township Treasurer for the same." shall be and is hereby amended to read as follows:

"The fee for issuing such permit or permits shall be the sum of Five Dollars (\$5.00) for a garage, the sum of Two Dollars Fifty Cents (\$2.50) for an addition thereto, the sum of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) for a residence or dwelling, the sum of Five Dollars (\$5.00) for an addition thereto, the sum of Twenty-five (\$25.00) for any building or structure where any portion of the whole thereof is built or constructed for commercial use and the sum of Cne Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for any building or structure where any portion of the whole thereof is built or constructed for industrial use and an additional sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) for each time plans and specifications are subsequently submitted to the Township Secretary, which said fees shall be paid to the Township Secretary by the applicant at the time the application or reapplication is made. The Township Secretary shall provide a suitable book for the purpose of keeping a record of all permits issued by him, and shall pay to the Township Treasurer all moneys received by him within the month for which the same are received, and shall make monthly reports to the Township Board of Commissioners of all permits issued, the amounts received therefor, together with his receipt from the Township Treasurer for the same."

2. That all ordinances or p conflicting with the provisions are hereby repealed.
