ORDINANCE NO. 67-1

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, VACATING A PORTION OF STRAWBERRY ALLEY IN THE SAYRE, HOGSETT AND MILLER PLAN OF LOTS IN SAID TOWNSHIP AS RECORDED IN PLAN BOOK VOL. 2, PAGE 93.

WHEREAS, after public hearing at the Hopewell Township
Municipal Building, Hopewell Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania,
on October 24, 1966, pursuant to notice required by Section 2007
of the First Class Township Code, the Board of Commissioners of
Hopewell Township on November 17, 1966 filed its Report in the
Court of Quarter Sessions of Beaver County, Pennsylvania at No. 1
November Sessions, 1966, approving the vacation of a portion of
Strawberry Alley as laid out in the Sayre, Hogsett and Miller Plan
of Lots, situate in said Township as said plan is recorded in the
Office of the Recorder of Deeds of Beaver County in Plan Book Vol.
2, page 93, more fully described as follows: See Exhibit "A"

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Hopewell Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same:

Section 1. The following unopened portion of Strawberry Alley be and the same is hereby vacated; subject to utility rights-of-way.

ALL that certain piece, parcel or tract of land lying and being situate in the Township of Hopewell, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, bounded and described as follows, to-wit:

BEGINNING at the intersection of the Southerly line of Strawberry Alley with the Easterly line of Second Alley, said Plan; thence by the said line of Second Alley, North 46° 45' West, for a distance of 20 feet to the Southerly line of Lot No. 17, said Plan; thence by the said line of Lot No. 17, North 43° 15' East, for a distance of 104 feet to the Westerly line of First Alley, if extended Northwardly; thence by the line of First Alley, if extended Northwardly, South 46° 45' East, for a distance of 20 feet to the Northerly line of Lot No. 5 in said Plan; thence by the Northerly line of Lots Nos. 5 and 6 in said Plan, South 43° 15' West, for a distance of 104 feet to the place of beginning.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall become effective on the earliest date provided by law.

Section 3. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same are repealed.

ORDAINED AND ENACTED into an Ordinance this 9th day of January, 1967.


