ORDINANCE NO. 67-2

AN CRDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, VACATING A PORTION OF STONER AVENUE IN BOTH THE SHANNOPIN HEIGHTS PLAN OF LOTS AND THE WICKHAM VILLAGE PLAN OF LOTS NO. 1 IN SAID TOWNSHIP AS RECORDED IN PLAN BOOK VOL. 2, pages 74 AND 75 AND PLAN BOOK VOL. 7, PAGE 55.

WHEREAS, after public hearing at the Hopewell Township
Municipal Building, Hopewell Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania,
on October 24, 1966, pursuant to notice required by Section 2007
of the First Class Township Code, the Board of Commissioners of
Hopewell Township on Nobember 17, 1966 filed its Report in the
Court of Quarter Sessions of Beaver County, Pennsylvania at No. 2
November Sessions, 1966, approving the vacation of a portion of
Stoner Avenue lying between Diamond Street and the Allegheny County
boundary line as it appears on both the Shannopin Heights Plan of
Lots and the Wickham Village Plan of Lots No. 1, situate in said
Township and recorded in the Recorder's Office of Beaver County
in Plan Book Vol. 2, pages 74 and 75 and Plan Book Vol. 7, page 55,
respectively, more fully described as follows: See Exhibit "A"

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED AND CRDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Hopewell Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same:

Section 1. The following unopened portion of Stoner Avenue be and the same is hereby vacated; subject to utility rights-of-way:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or tract of land lying and being situate in the Township of Hopewell, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, bounded and described as follows, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point at the Northeast corner of property conveyed to A.J. DeFerrari, et ux., in D.B. Vol. 900, page 122, on the Southerly side of Stoner Avenue; said point of beginning is also situate on the line dividing Hopewell Township in Beaver County from Crescent Township in Allegheny County (See Wickham Village Plan No. 1, P.B. 7, page 55); thence along Stoner Avenue in a Northwesterly direction, along the property lines of said A.J. DeFerrari et ux., and John Kobaly, et ux., North 55° 27' West, 548 feet more or less to a point; thence by a curve to the left, having a radius of 20 feet for an arc distance of 22.16 feet to a point on the Easterly side of Diamond Street if extended; thence along the Easterly side of Diamond Street if extended, North 51° 4' East, 81.4 feet more or less to a point on the Northerly side of Stoner Avenue; thence by the Northerly side of Stoner Avenue along the Southerly property lines of the Otto F. Troeger heirs and H. D. Thomas, Jr., et ux., South 66° 10' East, 550 feet more or less to a point on the Allegheny County-Beaver County line as shown on the aforesaid Wickham Village Plan No. 1; thence South 38° 4' West, 60 feet to a point, the place of beginning.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall become effective on the earliest date provided by law.

Section 3. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same are repealed.
