TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL

ORDINANCE NO. 67-3

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, APPROVING AND ADOPTING A PROPOSED AMENDMENT OF THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF CRESWELL HEIGHTS JOINT AUTHORITY, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, TO INCREASE THE TERM OF EXISTENCE OF SAID AUTHORITY FOR A PERIOD EXPIRING FIFTY (50) YEARS FROM THE DATE OF APPROVAL OF SUCH AMENDMENT.

WHEREAS, on January 3, 1950, the Secretary of the Commonwealth, of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, approved Articles of Incorporation of the CRESWELL HEIGHTS JOINT AUTHORITY, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, and on the same date issued a certificate of the incorporation of said Authority pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Authorities Act of May 2, 1945, P.L. 382, as amended; and

WHEREAS, said certificate of incorporation fixed the term of existence of said Authority at fifty (50) years which will therefore expire on January 3, 2000; and

WHEREAS, at a regular meeting of the Board of said Authority held on November 2, 1966, said Board adopted a resolution, a certified copy of which has been delivered to this Board, reciting the necessity for said Authority to secure additional capital funds for the purpose of financing plant expansion and improvement and, in order to obtain such financing on the most favorable terms, proposing an amendment to its Articles of Incorporation and extending its term of existence for a period of fifty (50) years from the date of approval of such amendment; and

WHEREAS, such proposed amendment must be approved by the governing bodies of each of the municipalities composing said Authority;

Now, Therefore, Be It Ordained and Enacted, by the Board of Township Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same:

SECTION 1. The Township of Hopewell, as one of the municipalities composing the Creswell Heights Joint Authority, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, does hereby approve and adopt the proposal of the Board of said Authority, as set forth in the resolution of said Board, adopted November 22, 1966, that the Articles of Incorporation of said Authority be amended by adding the follow-

ing Article thereto:

"(e) The term of existence of said Authority is hereby increased to expire on a date which shall be fifty (50) years from the date of approval of this Article of Amendment."

SECTION 2. The Secretary be and he is hereby instructed to deliver to said Board of the Creswell Heights Joint Authority, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, a duly certified copy of this Ordinance, and the proper officers of this Board be and they are hereby authorized and directed to take any and all such further action as may be necessary or required to evidence the approval of said proposed amendment by the Township of Hopewell.

SECTION 3. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed insofar as they affect this Ordinance.
