ORDINANCE NO. 67-6

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ELECTING TO JOIN THE MUNICIPAL EMPLOYES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM; AGREEING TO BE BOUND BY ALL THE REQUIREMENTS AND PROVISIONS OF THE MUNICIPAL EMPLOYES' RETIREMENT LAW, AS APPLICABLE TO MEMBER MUNICIPALITIES AND STATING WHICH OF CERTAIN OPTIONS PERMITTED UNDER THE SAID LAW ARE ACCEPTED BY THE SAID TOWNSHIP.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Hopewell Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same as follows:

Section 1. The Township of Hopewell having placed all of its employees, as far as they are eligible, under the Federal Social Security Act, hereby elects to join the Municipal Employes' Retirement System, established by the Act of June 4, 1943, P. L. 886, as last amended by the Act of August 24, 1963, No. 485, and does hereby agree to be bound by all the requirements and provisions of the said Act and to assume all obligations, financial and otherwise, placed upon member municipalities by said Act.

Section 2. Membership for elected officials shall be prohibited and membership for employees paid on a per diem basis shall be prohibited. Officers and employees paid wholly on a fee basis shall not be eligible for membership in the system.

Section 3. Credit for prior service toward the municipal annuity of each original member shall be for all years of service to the Township. The Township does hereby assume the liability for payment of one hundred per centum (100%) of the member's contributions for all years of service toward the member's annuity for the prior service of each original member.

Section 4. Payment for the prior service noted in Section 3 hereof shall be made by the Township in accordance with Section 14 of said Act and may be spread over a period of thirty (30) years if the Township so chooses and with the consent of the Municipal Employes' Retirement Board.

Section 5. The Township does hereby incorporate the said Municipal Employes' Retirement Law, as last amended by the Act of August 24, 1963, No. 485, as a part of this Ordinance insofar as the said Act, as amended, applies to a member municipality, having accepted the options set out in this Ordinance.

Section 6. The Township does hereby elect to extend the provisions of Section 20.1 of the Municipal Employes' Retirement Law, Act of June 4, 1943, P.L. 886, added by the Act of August 24, 1963, No. 485, so that contributors to the retirement system shall have the options and enjoy the protections of the provisions set forth in Subsections (a) and (b) of Sevtion 20.1 of the Municipal Employes' Retirement Law, and Section 20.1 is hereby incorporated and made a part hereof by reference thereto.

Section 7. A duly certified copy of this Ordinance shall be filed with the Municipal Employes' Retirement Board of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and membership for the Township in the Municipal Employes' Retirement System shall become effective the first day of June, 1967.
