ORDINANCE NO. 67-8

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, VACATING HOOD AVENUE BETWEEN THE BRODHEAD ROAD AND HARPER ROAD, FORMERLY ANDERSON ROAD, AS IT APPEARS IN THE SHANNOPIN HEIGHTS PLAN OF LOTS IN SAID TOWNSHIP AS RECORDED IN PLAN BOOK VOL. 2, PAGES 74 AND 75.

WHEREAS, after public hearing at the Hopewell Township Municipal Building, Hopewell Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, on April 26, 1967, pursuant to notice required by Section 2007 of the First Class Township Code, the Board of Commissioners of Hopewell Township on July 13, 1967 filed its Report in the Court of Quarter Sessions of Beaver County, Pennsylvania at No. 5 of 1967 Road Docket, approving the vacation of Hood Avenue between the Brodhead Road and Harper Road, formerly Anderson Road, as it appears in the Shannopin Heights Plan of Lots, situate in said Township and recorded in the Recorder's Office of Beaver County in Plan Book Vol. 2, pages 74 and 75, more fully described as follows: See Exhibit "A".

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Hopewell Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same:

Section 1. The following portion of Hood Avenue, an unopened street, between the Brodhead Road and Harper Road, formerly Anderson Road, be and the same is hereby vacated, subject to utility rights-of-way:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate in the Township of Hopewell, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, being more fully bounded and described as follows, to-wit:

BEGINNING on the northerly line of Hood Avenue where the same is intersected by the center line of the Brodhead Road; thence along the southerly line of Lots Numbered 48 to 54 inclusive in the plan aforesaid, South $81^{\circ} 00'$ East for a distance of 1129.80 feet to a point; thence along the southwesterly line of Lot numbered 48 in said plan aforesaid, South $28^{\circ} 19' 50''$ East for a distance of 246.21 feet to Anderson Road; thence along the said line of Anderson Road, South $51^{\circ} 43'$ West for a distance of 60.90 feet to a point; thence along Lots numbered 76 and 63 in said plan North $28^{\circ} 19' 50''$ West for a distance of 226.81 feet to a point; thence along the northerly line of Lots numbered 56 to 63 inclusive in the plan aforesaid North $81^{\circ} 00'$ West for a distance of 1073.28 feet to the center line of the Brodhead Road; thence along the center line of the Brodhead Road North $14^{\circ} 53'$ West for a distance of 65.65 feet to the point, the place of beginning.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall become effective on the earliest date provided by law.

Section 3. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same are repealed.
