ordinance no. 68-2

AN ORDINANCE OF HOPEWELL TOWNSHIP, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA APPROVING THE CONSTRUCTION AND ESTIMATED COST OF A CAPITAL ADDITION TO THE SANITARY SEWER SYSTEM TO THE EXISTING SEWERS IN THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA BY HOPEWELL TOWNSHIP AUTHORITY AND KNOWN AS SEWER EXPANSION PROJECT 1968, INCLUDING GENERAL CONSTRUCTION OF SANITARY SEWERS, GENERAL CONSTRUCTION OF A PUMP STATION AND ELECTRICAL WORK FOR THE PUMP STATION.

WHEREAS, design drawings for the construction of a capital addition and extension to the system of sanitary sewers, including lateral and service connections, a pump station, force main, and electrical work for the pump station, have been prepared by Duncan, Lagnese and Associates, Inc. and have been presented by the Hopewell Township Authority to the Board of Commissioners of Hopewell Township, and

WHEREAS, the said design drawings have been approved by the Sanitary Water Board of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and a permit will be granted or obtained by said Board to construct said capital addition and extension, including lateral and service connections, pump station and electrical work for the pump station, and said permit will be recorded in accordance with law, and

WHEREAS, said Municipal Authority estimates that the cost of construction will be \$185,000.00, and

WHEREAS, the Act of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, May 2, 1945 P.L. 382, as Amended, requires that the Commissioners of Hopewell Township approve the plans and estimated cost of construction before charges may be assessed against the properties benefited, improved or accommodated thereby according to the foot-front rule, and

WHEREAS, the said Act requires that the Commissioners of Hopewell Township approve the plans and estimated cost of construction of sewers before charges may be assessed against the properties benefited, improved or accommodated thereby according to the benefits rule.

NOW THEREFORE, be it Ordained and Enacted by the Commissioners of Hopewell Township, and it is hereby Ordained and Enacted by the authority of the same,

Section 1. The plan of construction fo the capital addition and extension, including lateral and service connections, pump station and the electrical work for the pump station, as set forth in the report of Duncan, Lagnese & Associates, Inc. dated the 1st day of April, 1968, and as shown on the design drawings of Duncan, Lagnese & Associates, Inc. dated March, 1968, is hereby approved.

Section 2. The Secretary of the Township shall keep on file at the principal office of the Township a copy of said engineering report and design drawing where they shall be open to inspection at all reasonable times.

Section 3. The construction of said capital additions and extensions, including lateral and service connections, force mains, pump stations and electrical work for the pump station, to the sanitary sewer system by the Hopewell Township Authority, with all necessary manholes and other necessary appurtenances is hereby approved at a cost not to exceed \$185,000.00.

Section 5. The proposal of Hopewell Township Authority to assess \$74,750.00 of the cost of construction of the assessible portions

of the capital addition and extensions, including lateral and service connections, to the sewer system against the properties benefited, improved or accommodated thereby according to the foot-front rule at \$6.50 per foot, with provision for equitable adjustment for corner and odd shaped lots is hereby approved.

Section 6. The proposal of Hopewell Township Authority to assess against the properties benefited, improved or accommodated thereby according to the benefit system where applicable, and where it is unable to assess by the foot-front rule is hereby approved, subject to the provisions of this Ordinance and of the provisions of the Municipality Authorities Act.

Section 7. Should any section or provision of this Ordinance be declared by any Court having jurisdiction to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole or any part thereof other than the part so declared to be invalid.
