AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING THE OFFICE OF TOWNSHIP MANAGER-SECRETARY IN SAID TOWNSHIP, PROVIDING FOR THE MANNER OF FILLING SAID OFFICE, TERM, COMPENSATION AND PROVIDES OF SAID OFFICE, POWERS AND DUTIES OF SAID OFFICE.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Commissioners of Hopewell Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same:

Section 1. The office of Township Manager-Secretary is hereby created by the Township of Hopewell, subject to the right of the Township, by ordinance, at any time to abolish such office.

Section 2. As soon as practicable after the enactment of this ordinance, the Board of Commissioners shall elect, by a majority vote of all its members, one person to fill the office of Township Manager-Secretary to serve a term of FOUR YEARS and until his successor is elected and qualifies.

Section 3. The Manager-Secretary shall be chosen solely on the basis of his executive and administrative abilities, with special reference to his actual experience in or his knowledge of accepted practices in respect to the duties of the office.

Section 4. The Township Manager-Secretary may be included in, bonded under and covered by the bonds now in force and effect for the Township Secretary.

Section 5. The Township Manager-Secretary shall receive compensation in the amount of Nine Thousand (\$9,000.00) Dollars per year.

Section 6. The Township Manager-Secretary shall hold the office of Township Secretary and shall perform all the duties of such office as now required by statute, Township ordinances, resolutions and agreements. He shall be the chief administrative officer of the Township and responsible to the Board of Commissioners as a whole for the proper and efficient administration of the affairs of the Township. His powers and duties shall relate to the general management of all Township business not expressly, by statute or ordinance, imposed or conferred upon other Township officers. The Board of Commissioners may delegate, subject to recall, any of their respective non-legislative and non-judicial powers and duties to said Township Manager-Secretary.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA ESTABLISHING THE OFFICE OF TOWNSHIP MANAGER-SECRETARY IN SAID TOWNSHIP, PROVIDING FOR THE MANNER OFFILLING SAID OFFICE, TERM, COMPENS OF AND OFFICE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Commissioners of Hopewell Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same:
Section 1. The office of Township Manager-Secretary is hereby created by the Township of Hopewell, subject to the right of the Township, by ordinance, at any time to abolish such office. Section 2. As soon as practicable after the enactment of this ordinance, the Board of Commissioners shall elect, by a majority vote of all its members, one person to fill the office of Township Manager-Secretary to serve a term of four years and until his successor is elected and qualifies.

Section 4. The Manager-Secretary shall be chosen solely on the basis of his executive and administrative abilities, with special reference to his actual experience in or his knowledge of accepted practices in respect to the duties of the office.

Section 4. The Township Manager-Secretary may be included in, bonded under and covered by the bonds now in force and effect for the Township Manager-Secretary shall receive compensation in the amount of Nine Thousand (89,000.00) Dollars per year.
