ORDINANCE NO. 69-4

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 65-7 ENACTED OCTOBER 11, 1965, KNOWN AS THE HOPEWELL TOWNSHIP REFUSE DISPOSAL ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Commissioners of Hopewell Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same:

1. That Section 3 (c) of said Ordinance No. 65-7, known as the Hopewell Township Refuse Disposal Ordinance is hereby amended as follows:

"On Annual Spring Clean-Up Day and Annual Fall Clean-Up Day as set, determined and announced by the Board of Commissioners."

2. That Section 3 (b) 5 of said Ordinance is hereby amended as follows:

"No licensed collector shall make any change in the method of collection, charge for collections or arrangements for disposal of refuse collection by him without first receiving the approval of the Board of Commissioners."

3. That Section 3 (c) 2 of said Ordinance is hereby amended as follows:

"It shall be unlawful to collect, haul, transport or convey garbage in open, unenclosed or canvas top vehicles."

4. The provisions of this ordinance shall be severable and if any of the provisions shall be held to be unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the validity of any of the remaining provisions of the ordinance.

5. All ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 65-7 ENACTED OCTOBER 11, 1965, KNOWN AS THE HOPEWELL TOWNSHIP REFUSE DISPOSAL ORDINANCE.
BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Commissioners of Hopewell Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same:
1. That Section 3 (c) of said Ordinance No. 65-7, known as the Hopewell Township Refuse Disposal Ordinance is hereby amended as follows:
"On Annual Spring Clean-up Day and Annual Fall Clean-Up Day as set, determined and announced by the Board of Commissioners."
2. That Section 3 (b) 5 of said Ordinance is hereby amended as follows:
"No licensed collector shall make any change in the method of collection, charge for collections or arrangements for disposal of refuse collection by him without first receiving the approval of the Board of Commissioners."
3. That Section 3 (c) 2 of said Ordinance is hereby amended as follows:
"It shall be unlawful to collect, haul, transport or convey garbage in open, unenclosed or canvas top vehicles."
4. The provisions of this ordinance shall be severable and if any of the provisions shall be held to be unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the validity of any of the remaining provisions of the ordinance.
5. All ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
