ORDINANCE NO. ⁶⁹⁻⁵

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA PRESCRIBING NO-PARKING REGULATIONS ON WOODBINE STREET FROM THE INTERSECTION OF BRODHEAD ROAD TO WIMPOLE STREET IN SAID TOWNSHIP AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Commissioners of Hopewell Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same:

Section 1. No parking at Any Time.

Parking shall be prohibited at all times on Woodbine Street from the intersection of Brodhead Road to the intersection of Wimpole Street in said Township.

Section 2. Penalty for Violation.

Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than Two Dollars (\$2.00) nor more than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) and costs of prosecution and, in default of payment of such fine and costs, to be imprisoned in the Beaver County Jail for not more than five (5) days for each violation.

ORDAINED AND ENACTED into an Ordinance this 8th day of September, 1969.
