ORDINANCE NO. 70-8

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA AUTHORIZING THE BOARD OF TOWNSHIP COMMISSIONERS, FROM TIME TO TIME, BY RESOLUTION, TO DESIGNATE CERTAIN STREETS AND SPECIFIED AREAS OF PRIVATE PROPERTY AS FIRE LANES, AND TO PROHIBIT PARKING THEREON IN ORDER TO PROMOTE AND BETTER PROVIDE FOR THE SAFETY OF THE CITIZENS AND RESIDENTS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL AND THEIR PROPERTY: AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION OF SUCH REGULATIONS.

WHEREAS, residential and commercial development in the township has resulted in traffic congestion on certain streets and on certain private properties devoted to commercial establishments, to the extent that in the event of fire, it may be impossible for fire fighting equipment to be properly located to successfully and most advantageously fight the fire; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it necessary in the interest of providing for and promoting the safety of the citizens and residents of the Township of Hopewell and their property, and properties of others located within the Township of Hopewell to designate, from time to time, by Resolution, certain streets and specified areas of private property as fire lanes, and to prohibit parking thereon.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Commissioners of Hopewell Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same:

SECTION I. The Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell may, from time to time, by Resolution, designate certain streets and specified areas of private property in the Township as fire lanes, and shall prohibit the parking of motor vehicles thereon. The areas so designated as fire lanes shall be so marked with appropriate signs identifying that the area is a fire lane and that parking of motor vehicles thereon is prohibited. If such areas are not identified by such signs, the fine imposed by this Ordinance shall not be applicable.

SECTION II. Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this Ordinance or any regulation or restriction hereafter adopted by Resolution pursuant hereto, shall, upon conviction thereof in any summary proceeding be sentenced to pay a fine of \$10.00 together with the costs of prosecution, and in default of the payment of such fine and costs, shall undergo imprisonment for a period not exceeding five (5) days.
