ORDINANCE NO. 7/-/

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, VACATING A PORTION OF WILSON ROAD AS IT APPEARS IN THE CLARK MANOR PLAN NO. 1 PLAN OF LOTS RECORDED IN BEAVER COUNTY PLAN BOOK VOL. 5, PAGE 85.

WHEREAS, after public hearing at the Hopewell Township
Municipal Building, Hopewell Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania,
on February 1, 1971, pursuant to notice required by Section 2007
of the First Class Township Code, the Board of Commissioners of
Hopewell Township on February 9, 1971 filed its Report in the Court
of Quarter Sessions of Beaver County, Pennsylvania at No. 3 of 1971
Road Docket, approving the vacation of a portion of Wilson Road as
it appears in the Clark Manor Plan No. 1 Plan of Lots recorded in
Beaver County Plan Book Vol. 5, Page 85, more fully described as
follows: See Exhibit "A".

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Hopewell Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same:

Section 1. The following portion of Wilson Road, an unopened street, be and the same is hereby vacated, subject to utility rights-of-way:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate in the Township of Hopewell, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, being more fully bounded and described as follows, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point, said point being the Northwestern corner of the parcel herein described and the Northeast corner of the property of Hopewell Township; thence along a line crossing Wilson Road N. 76° 40° 40° E. a distance of 40.01° to a point on the Easterly right-of-way line of Wilson Road; thence along the East-erly right-of-way line of Wilson Road and the Westerly property line of the H.I.R. School District, S. 14° 33° 30° E., a distance of 176.65° to a point; thence along the same Easterly right-of-way line of Wilson Road and the Westerly property line of the H.I.R. School District S. 31° 32° West, a distance of 274.76° to a point on the Northerly right-of-way line of Circle Drive; thence along the Northerly right-of-way line of Circle Drive; hence along the Northerly right-of-way line of Circle Drive, N. 54° 23° 30° W. a distance of 61.65° to a point at the intersection of the South-east property line of Hopewell Township and the Northern right-of-way line of Gircle Drive; thence along the Easterly right-of-way line of Hopewell Township and the Westerly right-of-way line of Wilson Road and the Easterly property line of Hopewell Township, N. 31° 32° E. a distance of 183.40° to a point; thence along the Westerly right-of-way line of Hopewell Township, N. 31° 32° E. a distance of 94.54° to a point; thence along the Westerly right-of-way line of Wilson Road and the Easterly property line of Hopewell Township and a curve to the right having a radius of 117.53° and an arc distance of 94.54° to a point; thence along the Westerly right-of-way line of Wilson Road and the Easterly property line of Hopewell Township N. 14° 33° 30° W. a distance of 110.34° to the point of beginning. Said parcel of land containing 0.4075 acres.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall become effective on the earliest date provided by law.

Section 3. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same are repealed.




