

ORDINANCE NO. 42-1

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL THE COUNTY OF BEAVER AND COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA REQUESTING AUTHORIZATION TO PARTICIPATE IN PURCHASE CONTRACTS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PROPERTY AND SUPPLIES OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA.

WHEREAS, Section 2403 of The Administrative Code of 1929 [71 P.S. § 633] has been amended to permit political subdivision to participate in purchase contracts for materials, supplies and equipment entered into by the Department of Property and Supplies of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, participation in purchase contracts of the Department of Property and Supplies should result in reduced costs to the Township with respect to certain purchases of materials, supplies and equipment and will eliminate the expense and attendant delay surrounding purchases made under existing legislation requiring competitive bidding;

NOW, therefore, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell, a municipal corporation under The First Class Township Code situate in the County of Beaver and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED:

SECTION 1. The Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell hereby requests that the Township be authorized to participate in and/or purchase off purchase contracts for materials, supplies and equipment entered into the Department of Property and Supplies of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

SECTION 2. As a condition of its participation, the Township of Hopewell hereby agrees that it will be bound by such terms and conditions as the Department of Property and Supplies

may prescribe and that the Township will be responsible for payment directly to the vendor under each purchase contract.

SECTION 3. That the Secretary of the Board is directed to file with the Department of Property and Supplies a certified copy of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance is enacted pursuant to the authority contained in Act No. 31 of 1971, signed into Law on July 9, 1971.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
