ORDINANCE NO. 72-2

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA AMENDING THE OFFICIAL ZONING ORDINANCE MAP OF ORDINANCE NO. 61-10, THE 1961 ZONING ORDINANCE OF HOPEWELL TOWNSHIP.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell, a municipal corporation under The First Class Township Code situate in the County of Beaver and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED:

That the Official Zoning Ordinance Map referred to and part of Township Ordinance No. 61-10, The 1961 Zoning Ordinance of Hopewell Township, is hereby amended to rezone the following parcel of land from R-2 Residential to C-2 Roadside Commercial:

BEGINNING at a post, thence by lands of Louis Steuer North 40° 30' West, a distance of 1519 feet; thence by lands now or formerly of John Schmidt South 40° 30' West, a distance of 359.8 feet; thence South 41° East, a distance of 786.5 feet; thence South 49° West, a distance of 180 feet; thence by lands now or formerly of John Schmidt South 41° East, a distance of 384.35 feet; thence by lands now or formerly of William Gray, North 74° 15' East, a distance of 197.25 feet to a post; thence North 11° West, a distance of 132 feet to a post; thence North 82° East, a distance of 330 feet to a post; thence South 4° East, a distance of 99 feet to a post; thence by land now or formerly of William Gray North 74° 15' East, a distance of 132 feet to a post at the place of beginning.
