AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 63-15 PROVIDING FOR INCREASE OF SCHOOLS RENTAL RATES FOR USE OF THE SEWER SYSTEM OPERATED BY THE TOWNSHIP PURSUANT TO THE TERMS OF A LEASE AGREEMENT ENTERED INTO WITH HOPEWELL TOWNSHIP AUTHORITY.
