ORDINANCE NO. 73-7

AN ORDINANCE OF HOPEWELL TOWNSHIP, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA APPROVING THE CONSTRUCTION AND ESTIMATED COST OF A CAPITAL ADDITION TO THE RACCOON CREEK WATER POLLUTION CONTROL PLANT IN THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA BY THE HOPEWELL TOWNSHIP AUTHORITY, INCLUDING PLANT EXPANSION, UPGRADING AND ELECTRICAL WORK FOR THE SAID POLLUTION CONTROL PLANT.

WHEREAS, design drawings for the construction of a capital addition and upgrading to the Raccoon Creek Water Pollution Control Plan and electrical work for the said plant, have been prepared by Duncan, Lagnese and Associates, Inc. and have been presented by the Hopewell Township Authority to the Board of Commissioners of Hopewell Township, and

WHEREAS, the said design drawings have been approved by the Federal and State regulatory agencies and a permit will be granted or obtained by said Board to construct said capital addition and extension, and said permit will be recorded in accordance with law, and

WHEREAS, said Municipal Authority estimates that the cost of construction will be \$1,207,379.00, and

WHEREAS, the Act of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, May 2, 1945 P.L. 382, as Amended, requires that the Commissioners of Hopewell Township approve the plan and estimated cost of construction.

NOW THEREFORE, be it Ordained and Enacted by the Commissioners of Hopewell Township, and it is hereby Ordained and Enacted by the authority of the same,

Section 1. The plan of construction for the capital addition and upgrading of the Raccoon Creek Pollution Control Plant and the electrical work for the said plant, as shown on the design drawings

of Duncan, Lagnese and Associates, Inc. dated June, 1970, with revisions to March 30, 1973, and as set forth in the report of Duncan, Lagnese and Associates, Inc. dated May 7, 1973, is hereby approved.

Section 2. The Secretary of the Township shall keep on file at the principal office of the Township a copy of said engineering report and design drawing where they shall be open to inspection at all reasonable times.

Section 3. The construction of said capital addition and extensions and electrical work to the Raccoon Creek Water Pollution Control Plant is hereby approved at a cost not to exceed \$1,207,379.00.

Section 4. Should any section or provision of this Ordinance be declared by any Court having jurisdiction to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole or any part thereof other than the part so declared to be invalid.

ORDAINED AND ENACTED finally into law by the Board of Township Commissioners this 6<sup>th</sup> day of June, 1973.
