ORDINANCE NO. 74-1

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA VACATING A PORTION OF TODD LANE, PUBLIC HIGHWAY WHOLLY SITUATE WITHIN THE SAID TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL.

WHEREAS, on October 15, 1973 the Board of Commissioners pursuant to notice as required by Section 2007 of The First Class Township Code, held a public hearing upon the petition of all the owners of abutting property to vacate that portion of Todd Lane hereinafter described; and

WHEREAS, as a result of said public hearing and in accordance with the mandate of Section 2008 of The First Class Township Code the Board of Commissioners has adopted a Report recommending the vacation of said portion of Todd Lane and has directed its Solicitor to file said Report in the Office of the Clerk of Quarter Sessions of Beaver County, Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, for the reasons contained in said Report the Board of Commissioners has determined to vacate said described portion of Todd Lane;

NOW, therefore, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell, a municipal corporation under The First Class Township Code situate in the County of Beaver and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, AND IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED:

1. That pursuant to the authority contained in Section 2005 of The First Class Township Code [53 P.S. 57005], and upon the petition of all the owners of property thereto abutting, the following portion of Todd Lane is hereby vacated:

DESCRIPTION OF VACATED PREMISES

TODD LANE - that portion thereof from its beginning formed by the extension of the northerly line of Green Garden Road (L.R. 04123) to its terminus at the southwesterly line of the Beaver Valley Expressway. Said portion of Todd Lane being bounded on its easterly line by lands of Taylor Milk Company as described in Beaver County Deed Book 620, page 284 (Tax Parcel 65-193-336) and Deed Book 641, page 109 (Tax Parcel 65-193-338), and on its westerly line by lands of Russell Dobish et ux. as described in Beaver County Deed Book 769, page 397 (Tax Parcel 65-193-335) 335).

That this Ordinance shall be effective thirty-five (35) days following its adoption.
