

Ordinance 74-2

Nine Persons Appointed

4/8/1974

AN ORDINANCE CREATING AND ESTABLISHING IN THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, A TOWNSHIP PLANNING COMMISSION OF NINE PERSONS TO BE APPOINTED BY THE HOPEWELL TOWNSHIP BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS.

WHEREAS, the Pennsylvania Legislature has by Act of July 31, 1968, as amended, by Act of June 1, 1972, No. 93, enacted legislation, known as the "Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code"; and

WHEREAS, said Code provides for the creation of a planning commission to be created in accordance with the provisions recited in the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell, a municipal corporation, under the First Class Township Code situate in the County of Beaver and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, AND IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED:

SECTION 1. That there is hereby created a planning commission consisting of Nine members to be known as "The Hopewell Township Planning Commission."

SECTION 2. That the term of each of the members of the commission shall be for four years, or until his or her successor is appointed and qualified, except that the terms of the members initially appointed under this ordinance shall be as follows:

Three members for two years

Three members for three years

Three members for four years

SECTION 3. That the term of office of said members shall be on a calendar year basis with all terms commencing as of January 1, 1974.

SECTION 4. That the Planning Commission shall conduct its business in accordance with the procedure outlined in Section 207 of the "Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code."

SECTION 5. That the powers and duties of the Planning Commission shall be those as outlined in Section 209.1 of the "Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code."

SECTION 6. All ordinances and resolutions or parts thereof of the Township of Hopewell, inconsistent in any manner with the provision of this ordinance, are hereby repealed.
